- **Wedding March** (From A Midsummer Night's Dream): Mendelssohn, only for the Recessional
- **Trumpet Voluntary**: Clarke
- **Overture** (from Fireworks Music): Handel
- **Prelude** (from the Te Deum): Charpentier
- **St Anthony Chorale**: Attributed to Haydn
- **Trumpet Voluntary Op 6 No. 5**: Stanley
- **Hornpipe**: Handel

Suggestions for Signing of the Register

- **Air** (from Suite No. 3): Bach
- **Minuet**: Bach
- **Air** (from Water Music): Handel
- **Siciliana**: Handel
- **Entr'acte** (from Rosamunde): Schubert
- **Canon in D**: Pachelbel
- **Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring**: Bach
- **Arioso**: Bach
- **Minuet**: Beethoven
- **Largo** (from Xerxes): Handel

If you're thinking of having hymns, it is advisable to consider whether the families and friends at the wedding would be comfortable singing hymns. If not, a soloist or choir could sing, or hymns could be omitted from the wedding service.
